Discovery Range 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon

90 pt Robert Parker - Advocate "Juicy raspberry and cherry, spice and mocha. 90 pt | Gary Walsh | Medium bodied, light grainy tannin, nice shape in the mouth" 91 pt Jordan | Top 100 West Australian

Cabernet Sauvignon's sculpted tannins and lifted red berry perfumes combine with a splash of Merlot, Malbec and Cabernet Franc to enhance palate extension, fleshiness and early approachability. A combination of personality and purpose for those who enjoy soft tannins, succulent red fruits and simply love wine. A superb follow on to the highly acclaimed 2013 vintage which earned a 95 pt Halliday review.

Food matching	Grilled Argentinian Beef ribs steak strong cheese
Variety	Cabernet Sauvignon 90% Merlot 8% Malbec 1% Cabernet Franc 1%
Maturation	In used 225L French oak for one year. Mainly from the Allier and Center of France forests.
Winemaking	The varietals were fermented and matured separately in French oak for a year. They were blended just before bottling based on precise tasting profile
Cellaring Potential	Up to 5 years, but delicious now.
Harvested	Cabernet 9 th April, Merlot and Cab Franc 14 th April and Malbec 24 th March
Growing Season	A great example of a maritime climate with an extended Indian Summer which offered physiologically ripe fruit.
Alcohol	13.8%by Vol 8.2 Standard Drinks
